

Making Questions in present

Present Progressive

Simple Present

3rd Person Singular:	Jack is working Right now.	Jack works every day
3rd Person Singular:	Is Jack working Right now?	Does Jack work every day?
3rd Person Plural:	They are playing.	They work every day.
3rd Person Plural:	Are they playing?	Do they work every day?
TIPS :	Change the word order.	Use "do" with a simple verb.
