1st person plural	we	ourselves	3) Reflexives are used to emphasize the object. -I spoke to the President himself. -He was told by the teacher herself.
2nd person plural	you	yourselves	
3rd person plural	they	themselves	4) Reflexives follow the preposition "by" to emphasize that the subject is alone. -Kate went to the movies by herself.
